Victor has been restoring it for the last few years and has a wealth of information on this bit of our local history.

At the meeting we will also vote on a needed and revised list of Bylaws for our organization, and of course we will have elections for the Board and Officers. Gorge Geology Tour with Lloyd DeKay

If you want to go on the Gorge Geology tour and learn a whole lot about why our neighborhood looks the way it does, here's all you need to know... It starts Saturday, June 1st, 2024 at the Original Courthouse Museum with an 8:30 a.m. orientation lecture by Lloyd. We will then take a tour bus on a 50 mile loop up to Hood River, across to Bingen and then back to The Dalles with 12 to 15 stops at sites of geological significance. We will stop for a no-host lunch along the way, at a location chosen by group consensus. Of course you are free to bring along a packed lunch or have your meal provided by your valet if you have one... Then, full and well informed, we will return to the Original Courthouse Museum around 3:30 in the afternoon. This is open to anyone and the cost is \$40.00 for current paid OWCC members, and \$45.00 for others. Those of you who attended Lloyd's presentation, in 2023, will know that your gonna get your money's worth and come away with a solid understanding of why the Gorge looks the way it does. You must be signed up by May 25th. Seating is limited so sign up soon! A Sign Of The Times?

So one of those times that great minds got together and hatched out an idea came up with a plan to set a post in the ground out in front of the museum and cover it with signs that tell which direction and how many miles one had to go to find other pockets of European civilization (or gold, or soldiers, or religion, or whiskey...)

So that would maybe include Canyon City (225 miles), Cross Hollow, *now Shaniko* (68), Oregon City (105) Fort Simcoe (103), Fort Boise (350), The Whitman Mission (153) goofy name places like Bakeoven (60) and of course where it all started, Independence, Missouri (2065 miles).

This seems like an ideal opportunity to expand our collective base of knowledge by inviting our membership to pitch in some names and distances for this project. Just remember these few simple rules... It has to be a location that existed (and was known about) after 1859 and before 1883. This sign is for folks back then, so use the name that was in use between those dates. It should have direct relevance to the courthouse, so probably no room for Tokyo or Dublin. Also, figure the mileage from back



then. No freeway miles or scenic shortcuts. stage routes and Oregon Trail only...
